

YCSSW offers Specialized Master of Social Work (MSW) program and a Generalist Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) on full-time basis. Established in 1994, YCSSW has completed an eventful 27 years of contribution to value based Social Work Education,

YCSSW stands apart from other educational institutions in its educational and ethical focus to provide students with a holistic education that addresses mind, body and soul. At YCSSW, education has always been linked to ethical and moral growth of the individual. It is the heart of the institution to make sure every student that leaves the college not only gets the best education possible, but also is transformed into the best citizen of the country. The unique facilities and innovative programs of YCSSW make it a premiere choice for the study of Social Work. The major purpose behind establishing the YashwantraoChavan School of Social Work is to develop and maintain it, as a centre for higher learning research, development and consultancy.

The full time courses offered at YCSSW are:

## Faculty Development:

During this period, all the faculty have attended FDP/Workshop/conference/refresher course on either online or offline mode. This has helped them to gain knowledge of relevant topics. Foru of the teaching faculties are on the verge to submit Ph.D.

### Computer Lab and Office:

In year 2020-21, computer lab has been updated by purchasing 15 desktops for the use of students and one laptop for the use of teachers. Also, Office has been updated for easy access to the students.

#### Social Responsibility Initiatives

- During the COVID 19 period as a social responsibility we were involved in different
  activities to support the needy and poor people in the society. We have distributed ration
  kits to around 7000 families of villages in Satara district in collaboration with different
  industries.
- 302 home isolated Corona patients were given online counseling.
- We have intervened in flood relief work in 2019. 20 students and two faculties stayed in Khidrapur Village, District Sangli for four days & had participated in rehabilitation activities. Also we had distributed dry ration kits to around 300 families.
- On a regular basis we are conducting legal awareness programmefor women in villages.
   We are associated with National, State women commission, District Legal Services department & department of Women and Child Welfare.
- We have two family counselling centers sponsored by central social welfare board, New Delhi, which is operated from Karad and Satara Police stations. On an average 300 - 400 family issuesare sorted out every year through these centers.
- We are also having VIHHAN as a care and support centre for HIV/AIDS patients.
   Through these centres patients of Satara districts are benefited in various fronts.
- During covid-19 pandemic, there was utter need form society which gave a boost to volunteerism in our college wherein, 45 students volunteered for paralegal awareness

These entire programmes were organised in collaboration with NGOs, government departments and industries. Regular awareness programs on mental health, superstition, addiction, community participation, etc. are the part and parcel of our educational programme taking into consideration the principle of learning by doing. Recognising the need, we have started working with Transgender as well. All our activities are need based and situation based. We promptly respond to any crisis situation as per our capacity and do network with likeminded stakeholders.

**School social work** is another area where we have intervened to deal with the issues of students and teachers. Our parent institute has 8 primary and secondary ashram schools and one junior college to cater to the educational needs of VJNT community. Around 1000 students are studying here and the institute takes care of their accommodation and food. School social work is being practiced in these schools under the able guidance of faculty members. All our activities are concentrated on the downtrodden section of the society.
